
Purpose of the Dress Code

- Build pride in our school community and values.
- Promote fairness, equity, and belonging for all students.
- Present a positive image to the community.
- Provide safe, functional, and economical clothing.
- Uphold the traditions of our school colours and logo.
- Prepare students for the world of work post schooling where compliance with dress codes is often a requirement.

North Rockhampton State High School's dress code is regulated under the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 and endorsed by the Parents & Citizens Association. Uniform items to be purchased from the school's uniform shop (beside the Tuckshop, under C Block).



SPORTS UNIFORM



* DTM workshops, Science, HPE, Food Technology, Art: closed-in leather/vinyl shoes required. Steel caps are permitted in DTM workshops.

FORMAL UNIFORM



HAIR

Hair must be neat, clean, off the face, and in natural colours.

Long hair tied back where required for safety.

Extreme or inappropriate hairstyles are not permitted.

Makeup not permitted (except clear lip gloss or sunscreen foundation for medical purposes).

JEWELLERY

Watch (smart watches must have notifications silenced)

Plain ear studs/sleepers

Clear studs/bars for facial piercings

One ring

One necklace (kept out of sight)

Medi-alert items allowed

Uniform Support

- Report to Student Services before school where you will be supplied with loan uniform item/s for the day
- Non-compliance with changing into loan item as required will be reported to Sub-school Head of Department
- Parents may be contacted to support compliance.

Free Dress Days

- Fully enclosed shoes are required
- Clothing must be sun safe - e.g. no singlets
- No bare midriffs, short shorts or offensive slogans or images are permitted
- If it is a themed out of uniform day, the theme must be adhered to, or students will be required to change into uniform.

Non-Compliance

If a student does not follow the dress code, consequences may include:

- Detention
- Removal from activities not considered essential to education
- Parent contact and requirement to correct uniform.

Can I wear a formal shirt with sports shorts?

- No. Students are to wear the complete formal uniform or the complete sports uniform.
