

Year 7 Subject Overview

Year 7 students will study the following mandatory subjects:

- English
- Maths
- Science
- Social Science

HPE and Japanese will be studied on a rotational basis – see table below.

In 2019, students in Years 7 and 8 will study Japanese and HPE. These classes are timetabled as a rotation across the subject line.

For example, if a student studies HPE (A) in Semester one for 2 lessons, their third lesson for that Semester will be JAP (A). In Semester 2, this will flip and they will student 1 lesson of HPE (A) and 2 lessons of JAP (A).

See example below.

WOW classes have been created to support students who have been identified as below National Minimum Standard on their NAPLAN testing. These students will not have Japanese timetabled as a subject. Parents are required to complete an Application for Exemption (Mandatory Languages) for students to participate in these classes.
