

YEAR 10 - SENIOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING (SET) PLAN

In Year 10, students work with their school, parents/carers and other learning providers to develop a Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan.

The SET plan helps students:

- structure their learning in Years 11 and 12 around abilities, interests and ambitions
- think about their education, training and career options after Year 12
- set and achieve learning goals in Years 11 and 12, and beyond
- include flexible and coordinated pathway options in their course of senior study
- communicate with parents/carers or teachers/careers counsellors about post-school plans.

Once the SET Plan is completed, the student and the key people involved in developing the plan should sign and date the plan to show agreement.

It is recommended that SET Plan are reviewed regularly to make sure subjects and learning are the 'right fit' and that students can maintain a pathway to the courses and career they want after Year 12.

Students wanting to make a change to their subjects or courses must discuss this with their school or other learning provider. Approval from school or learning provider must be received before changes are made.

SET PLANS - Key dates - Term Two

Students will engage in preparation for SET Plan interviews in the following manner;

- Subject talks hosted by HODs (lesson one every day Week 4 & 5)
- Online 'Subject Survey Forms' open Friday Week 5 - 18 May, close Wednesday Week 6 - 23 May
- Parent Information - Subject selection / new QCE information session Term 2 Week 7 - Wednesday 30 May
- Draft SET Plan completion in HAWKS lessons weeks 7, 8 & 9
- SET PLAN Interviews Week 9 - **Wednesday 13 & Friday 15 June 2018.**

Reminder Yr. 10 students ONLY attend for their interview on these days, no regular classes for Yr. 10s on these two days (Thursday 14 June is Show holiday).

Parents will book SET Plan interviews online as per parent teacher conferences, more information to come.

NEW QCE 2019

Students in Year 10 in 2018 will be the first to enter the new QCE (Queensland Certificate of Education) in 2019 and graduate with new QCE qualification and ATAR (Australian tertiary acceptance rank).
