Bursary Benefits

- One set of the Formal Uniform to the value of \$100.00 for Year 7, to be spent in one transaction.
- The honour of being awarded a bursary.

Who can apply?

Any student about to enter Year 7 in 2023 and planning to attend North Rockhampton High School. Students from all primary schools are welcome to apply. You can apply for any bursary but cannot be awarded more than one. If applications aren't of a suitable standard, we may not award all bursaries in a given year.

How will the bursary winners be selected?

A panel consisting of the Principal and a P&C Association representative will review applications and select the bursary recipients. The decision of the panel will be final. Successful applicants will be advised in writing.

What happens after the recipients are selected?

The successful student and parents will be contacted and arrangements made to present the bursary at the final parade of the student's primary school.

During the period of the bursary, the recipients will be expected to continue to show the qualities for which they were awarded. In cases where this does not occur, the bursary may be withdrawn.

Why have bursaries at North Rockhampton State High School?

North Rockhampton State High School has a long tradition of achievement in all areas of student endeavour.

The aim of bursaries is to reward, encourage and promote excellence within the school community. By supporting students with a proven record, North Rockhampton State High School encourages you to strive for even greater success both for yourself and for your school.

The vision of our school is to achieve the highest possible learning outcomes for each student. However, the NRSHS experience goes far beyond the classroom. We nurture the growth of whole girls and boys and provide opportunities for our students to participate and excel in activities they are passionate about.

In 2022 our new bursary will be offered to two successful applicants and will run for two consecutive years.

Our ambition is to develop a School of Excellence in Rugby League where all students, boys and girls can achieve their potential.

What does the bursary cover for the successful student?

The Rugby League Bursary will cover the following costs for two consecutive years:

- playing uniform (school socks, shorts and training shirt)
- registration for Rugby League and Rugby Union (currently \$20, but may be subject to change)
- travel cost to any competitions played outside of Rockhampton District where a bus is provided (subject to change depending on competitions entered and success)

Who can apply?

Any student about to enter Year 7 in 2023 and planning to attend North Rockhampton High School. Students from all primary schools are welcome to apply.

How do I apply for a bursary?

1. Select which bursary you will apply for.
2. Prepare a written application outlining your details and achievements. The back page of this booklet tells you what to include.
3. The application may be handwritten or typed, and must be the work of the student applying. Applications should be signed by both the student and a parent.
4. Submit your bursary by the due date on the front of this booklet.

How will the bursary winners be selected?

A panel consisting of the Principal, Head of Health and Physical Education and Head of Junior Secondary schooling will review applications and select the bursary recipients. The decision of the panel will be final. Successful applicants will be advised in writing.

What happens after the recipients are selected?

The successful student and parents will be contacted and arrangements made to present the bursary at the final parade of the student's primary school.

During the period of the bursary, the recipients will be expected to continue to show the qualities for which they were awarded. In cases where this does not occur, the bursary may be withdrawn.

Will bursaries always be presented?

These bursaries are an annual award. However, if applications do not reach a suitable standard in a given year the bursary may not be presented.
